The Scrutineer's Examination is available to candidates of 21 years of age and older and is offer to:

- Any CDF member who is in good standing.
- Anyone who wishes to certify at this level of expertise in order to orientate one's career as a Scrutineer.
- CDF certified teachers, who old a National Championship Adjudicator's licence and who wish to become a CDF licensed Chairperson of Adjudicators.

THE EXAMINATION

The Scrutineer's Examination

- The exam is done under the Skating System and is supervised by one invigilator.
The time limit for the exam is 40 minutes. The exam sheets are sent to CDF Scrutineers Examiner Mr. Michel Guimond to be evaluated.
- The examination process may include a fee to be paid to the invigilator.

Please note that the scrutineer's examination has to be 100% accurate.

There will be no credit nor reimbursement for an incomplete or failed examination.
